

PARSONS, KERMIT ROOSEVELT

April 26, 1909-February 5, 1956

Services were held Wednesday, February 8, at the Schrader chapel for Kermit Roosevelt Parsons who passed away February 5 at the Veterans hospital in Cheyenne after a lengthy illness.

Mr. Parsons was born in Cornell, Nebr., April 26, 1909 and died at the age of 46 years. He was a resident of Wheatland since 1919 and had been employed by Paul Brewer prior to his illness.

He entered the service in 1940 and was discharged in 1945 after serving in both the Pacific and European theater, and was part of the honor guard at President Franklin D. Roosevelt's funeral service.

Last rites were conducted by Rev. Beryl Ellis with burial in the Wheatland cemetery.

He is survived by two brothers, Perry Parsons of Wheatland and William Parsons of Laramie; three sisters, Mrs. Wilma VanOrtwick and Mrs. Adah Huntzinger, both of St. Helen's, Ore., and Mrs. Ella Williams of Wheatland.
