

PARSONS, MYRTLE L. CHESSMORE

August 15, 1879-October 2, 1955

Funeral services were held yesterday (Wednesday) for Mrs. Myrtle L. Parsons, 76, of Wheatland who passed away in a local hospital last Sunday, October 2. She had been in poor health for some time. Born Myrtle Chessmore near Cedar Rapids, Ia., August 15, 1879, the deceased had lived in Wheatland since 1919. She was a member of the Nazarene church in Wheatland.
