succumbs May 10

James A. Payne, age 72, succumbed from a sudden heart attack at his farm near Glendo May 10, 1963. Mr. Payne was born in Polk Town, Ia. to Albert and Minnie Payne on September 26, 1890. He homesteaded on his farm 20 miles east of Glendo in 1914, and was united in marriage to Amy Smith at Wheatland in 1915.

Services were held at the Schrader chapel in Wheatland on May 14, 1963 with Rev. Frank Bozart officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery. Henry Mowry, Gilbert Hughes, J. A. Foreman, C. A. Thomas, Everett Engling and Roy McCormick served as pallbearers.
