

PEEK, MICHAEL FRANKLIN
April 10, 1951-November 9, 1969

Mike Peek, 18, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Peek of Casper, and grandson of Mr. and Mrs. S.R. Mills of Wheatland, died Sunday of carbon monoxide poisoning.

The youth was apparently overcome by the gas as he slept on the backseat of an automobile driven by Michael Hinton of Casper. The boys were returning from Denver when Hinton stopped in Douglas where Peek was pronounced dead. An autopsy was performed Monday.

Peek was born April 10, 1951, in Ogden, Utah and moved to Casper six years ago with his family. He graduated from Natrona County High School in June and was a freshman at Casper College. He was a member of the youth group at Richard Street Chapel.

The youth is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Fred Peek (formerly Marion Mills of Wheatland); brothers, Robert Burden, Glennallen, Alaska, J. Peek, serving in Okinawa in the Army, Richard and Steve at home; sisters, Mrs. Linda Conrad, Pomona, Calif., and Sandra and Julie at home; grandparents, Mrs. H.A. Peek, Ogden, Utah, Mr. and Mrs. S.R. Mills, Wheatland, Mrs. Ada Burden, Douglas, Perry Burden, Holden, Mo; and a niece and nephew of California.
