

PETERS, JOHN HENRY  
February 18, 1887-November 13, 1947

John H. Peters, for more than 25 years partsman for Park-to-Park Garage and for 44 years a resident of Wheatland, died suddenly at his home at two o'clock Thursday morning.

He had remarked to members of the force of the garage Wednesday of not feeling very well and at home shortly before stricken with the heart attack had risen and stated he was ill. Mrs. Peters called the family doctor and shortly after, Mr. Peters dropped to the floor and breathed his last soon after the doctor's arrival.

Mr. Peters, in his accustomed place at the garage and for years with the late A.C. Haeberle, had made many acquaintances throughout the county who will grieve with his family and close friends in his sudden death.

John Henry Peters was born February 18, 1887 in Columbus, Nebraska, and came to Wheatland in 1903. He is survived by his wife Leona, a son, Stanley, and one grandson. He was a member of the IOOF and Masonic lodges.

Funeral services will be held Sunday at 2 p.m. at the Congregational church with Rev. James Hoare officiating. Interment will be made in the Wheatland cemetery with the IOOF in charge of the services at the grave. Members of the Mason lodge will attend the funeral in a body.
