

Ivin Peterson Dies In Cheyenne Hospital June 12

Ivin Anderson Peterson, 85, a Wheatland resident for nearly 30 years, died Saturday, June 12, 1971, following a short illness at the Memorial Hospital in Cheyenne.

Mr. Peterson was born in Ong, Nebraska on November 16, 1885. He married Cena Marie Miller in 1909 in Orleans, Nebraska and they had one son, Richard Lee. Retired after 60 years of practicing pharmacy, Mr. Peterson had lived in Wheatland for the past 27 years. Prior to that, they lived in Glendo. An active member of the United Church of Christ, he also was a member of the Masonic Lodge, Wyoming Consistory No. 1, Korein Shrine and had his 50 year pin in the Masonic Lodge.
