

PHELPS, LUELLA LANE
November 24, 1866-February 17, 1920

Luella Lane was born November 24, 1866, at Agency City, Wapale county, Iowa. She was united in marriage to Henry A. Phelps on July 31, 1894 at Holyoke, Colorado. On the following year, Mr. and Mrs. Phelps moved to Wyoming, settling on the Fish Creek homestead, the site of the present Phelps ranch. Seven children were born to them here, the Misses Mary, Helen and Grace, and Dawson, Earl, Paul and Forrest Phelps. When the children reached high school age, they moved to the vicinity of Wheatland, living first on the present Jack Ross farm and later on the farm recently sold by John Leber, which Mr. Phelps owned for several years. For the last two years, they have been residing mainly at Laramie, where four of the children are now attending the state university.

Mrs. Phelps passed from this life on Tuesday, Feb. 17, 1920 leaving to her sorrowing family the memory of a live of devotion and sacrifice for her loved ones. "And her children shall call her blessed."
