

PHELPS, MARY WARREN
August 7, 1877-February 13, 1927

Mrs. Mary Phelps who died Sunday morning was laid to rest in the Wheatland cemetery Wednesday afternoon following services by Rev. R.L. Stratton, pastor of the Baptist church. The funeral arrangements were in charge of the Watson Mortuary.

Mary Shake-Phelps, daughter of Samuel and Nancy Warren, was born in La Rue county, Kentucky, August 7, 1877 and died at Wheatland, Wyo., February 13, 1927, age 49 years, 5 months and six days. On November 16, 1892, she was married to G.D. Shake. To this union was born nine children, five of whom survive her and were present at her funeral; Russell Shake, New York City; Sarah Rogers, Hillsdale, Wyo.; Elmer Shake of Albin, Wyo.; Alice Bougsty, Cheyenne, and Shirley Shake of Wheatland and eight grandchildren. She leaves six brothers, Lee, Henry, William, Thomas, Arvy, and Charles Warren, and a sister, Minnie Macomber. On June 26, 1926, in the city of Denver, the deceased was married to Henry A. Phelps who also survives her. She was a member of the local Baptist church.
