

## Services Tues. for Edward Phillippi

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday afternoon at the Methodist church for Edward Lee Phillippi, 26. Rev. Clifford Polson, Sr. officiated at the services.

Besides his mother, Kathryn Phillippi Baker he is survived by a brother, Jack Phillippi of Cheyenne and a sister, Mrs. Betty Yost of Wheatland. His father and two sisters preceded him in death.

## Woman Finds Man's Body In Vehicle

CASPER, Wyo. (UPI) — The body of a 26-year-old Casper man who had been missing since July 8 was found Sunday afternoon on an isolated mountain.

Miss Shirley Kettle of Casper discovered the body of Edward Philip in his automobile with a hose extending from the exhaust to a small break in the window. Death was ruled an apparent suicide by Casper authorities.

Philip's absence was first noticed by his employer in Casper who said he owed him \$130. His parents, who live in Wheatland, are the man's remaining survivors.

Philip was believed to have been despondent for some time.
