Mabel Marie Pitcher passed away Saturday, October 23, 1976 at the age of 78 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing. Funeral services were held Tuesday, October 26, 1976 at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home with the Rev. C. W. Livers officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
