

10-24 Rupert L. 'Warpy' Potter 1987

Funeral services for Rupert L. "Warpy" Potter, 75, of Lingle, will be held at 11 a.m. today at the Assembly of God Church in Wheatland with Pastor Elmer Hassler officiating.

Burial will be in the Wheatland Cemetery. A memorial has been established to the Lingle Rescue Unit.

Mr. Potter died at Platte Co. Memorial Hospital in Wheatland on Saturday, Oct. 24, 1987.

He was born Sept. 22, 1912 at Wheatland, the son of Frederick Lyman and Margaret Mae (Robertson) Potter. He grew up and attended school at Wheatland and worked with his father in the family concrete business in Wheatland.

During World War II Mr. Potter served in the U.S. Army. On Nov. 12, 1949 he married Thelma Kissel at Wheatland and he continued in the concrete business until 1968 when they moved to Lingle. He worked at Couplomatic in Lyman, Nebr., until he retired in 1977.

Survivors include brother Leslie Potter of Wheatland and sisters Gertrude Beebe of Signal Hill, Calif., and Agnes Meehan of Conroe, Texas. He was preceded in death by his wife Thelma in 1983 and four brothers and one sister.
