

Alvera Mahala (Dooley) Prewitt

March 29, 1918 – November 1, 2008

A funeral service for Alvera Mahala Prewitt will be conducted at 10:00 A.M., Friday, November 7, 2008, at Memorial Baptist Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Pastor Craig Cagle officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

She was called to her Savior Saturday, November 1, 2008, in North Platte, Nebraska, after a lengthy illness.

Alvera was born March 29, 1918, in Franklin, Nebraska, the daughter of Wilfred Angus and Adel (Smith) Dooley. She graduated in 1936 from Mullen High School in Nebraska. On February 4, 1939, Alvera married Warren Howard Prewitt in Alliance, Nebraska. A daughter and two sons were born to this union.

In 1947, the family moved from the Prewitt Ranch near Hyannis, Nebraska, to the North Laramie River Ranch at Wheatland, Wyoming. Alvera was a hardworking ranch wife. She raised and butchered 100's of chickens, milked cows, raised a large garden and canned everything, cooked for haymen and harvesters, and sewed the family's western wear. She was a member of Memorial Baptist Church, Chapter AW P.E.O., and the Laramie River Ranchers Ladies Club.
