Services for Judith Ann Preuit Proulx, 17, who died Oct. 12, 1980, were held Friday at the First Christian Church with the Rev. Jim Hicks officiating.

Judith, or "Pud" as she was called by her family and friends, was born Oct. 22, 1963 to Mr. and Mrs. Richard Preuit in Wheatland. She was educated in the Wheatland school system and was active in baseball and bowling leagues and the Girl Scouts. Her interests also included fishing, swimming and traveling. As she is remembered by loved ones a poem by Helen Steiner Rice titled "The Joy of Unselfish Giving" is listed as best expressing Judith's philosophy of life.

Earlier this year Judith married Bert Loren Joseph Proulx. They became the parents of daughter, Bobbi Jo.

Other survivors besides her widower, daughter, and parents include a sister, Vicki of Wheatland; two brothers, Edwin of Denver, Colo., and Richard of California.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
