

PULVER, SETH A.
April 6, 1873-March 9, 1953

Seth A. Pulver, 79, a resident of Platte county since 1917, died at a local hospital, Monday, March 9, after an extended illness. Prior to coming to Wheatland where he had made his home the past few years, Mr. Pulver was employed by the town of Guernsey for several years and also worked for a time for the railroad. He was a retired farmer.

Mr. Pulver was born in Wisconsin April 6, 1873.

He leaves two daughters, Mrs. Mervin Clark of Wheatland and Mrs. Grace McAdams of Camden, Ark.; three sons, Richard and Lynn, both of Wheatland and Harry of Austin, Minn.; and 13 grandchildren and 20 great grandchildren also survive the deceased.

Funeral services were held at the Schrader chapel at 2 o'clock this afternoon (Thursday), Rev. Howard Rice gave the funeral sermon. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
