The lady who never met a stranger, Marjorie Neola (Corbin) Ralls, 84, passed away Saturday, November 13, 1999, at the Ivinson Memorial Hospital in Laramie.

Graveside services and interment for Marjorie were held Wednesday, November 17, 1999, at 11 a.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery in Wheatland with Reverend Robert Moon officiating.

Marjorie was born August 3, 1915 in Gallatin, Mo., the daughter of Fred and Vassie (Bennett) Corbin. She was reared and educated in Missouri and married John Franklin Ralls on June 24, 1933 in Chillicothe, Mo.
