

RAWLINGS, JACQUILINE LEE
March 11, 1934-January 27, 1943

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at the Watson-Dennis chapel for Jacqueline Lee Rawlings, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J.O. Rawlings who died last Wednesday at the age of nine years. The little girl succumbed to pneumonia after a short illness.

Rev. Harry Allen officiated at the services and six third-grade pupils, classmates of Jacqueline, served as pallbearers. They were Dennis Hutchinson, Don Judge, Tommy Baxter, Joe Stoneking, Darrel Simon and Bernard Rumsey. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
