

REERINK, CARL  
February 11, 1892-August 3, 1973

Funeral services were held Monday, August 6, 1973, at 10:00 a.m. for Carl Reerink, 81, at the Schrader Chapel with Rev. Elliott Graves officiating.

Mr. Reerink died Friday, August 3, 1973, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital following a brief illness.

Carl Reerink was born in Tella, Iowa, February 11, 1892. He married Hazel Hightower December 8, 1920 in Wheatland, Wyoming. He was a veteran of World War I. Mr. Reerink had been a resident of this community since 1916. He was employed as a carpenter but was retired at the time of his death.

Mr. Reerink leaves to survive his widow, Hazel, Wheatland, and one son, Roy Reerink, Omaha, Nebraska, and four grandchildren. He was preceded in death by three brothers and one sister.
