

Martha M. Rehorst

March 24, 1916 – April 9, 2015

Graveside services for Martha M. Rehorst, 99, were Tuesday, Apr. 14 at the Wheatland Cemetery in Wheatland with Pastor Andy Gudahl of the First Christian Church officiating.

Martha Rehorst passed away on Thursday, Apr. 9 at the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland.

Martha was born March 24, 1916 to Peter and Amelia (Loring) Stamm in Goshen County.

Martha grew up on the family farm attending school in Veteran. She had to quit school in the sixth grade to care for her father.

Martha married Lewis Podio in 1942 in East Oakland, Calif. while he was in the Navy; they moved to Four Corners and farmed for 23 years. After he died in 1965, she continued farming and married Howard Rehorst in 1972. Howard died in 1982. Martha's love was farming, driving tractor and caring for the animals. She retired in 1979.

Martha attended the United Church of Christ and was confirmed in Wheatland in 1932. She belonged to the VFW Women's Auxiliary and was

a lifetime member of the Spearfish auxiliary.

Martha is survived by two sisters, Rose Howe of Gillette and Pauline Shultz of North Platte, Neb.; one brother, Jake Stamm of North Platte; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Martha was preceded in death by her parents; her first and second husbands; her son, Donald Ray Tedrow; three sisters, Emma Spires, Lydia Schrader, and Sadie Goetz; and six brothers, Johnny, Frederick, Fred, Joseph, David, and Benjamin Stamm.

Martha will be remembered as a kind hearted, fun-loving woman with many friends. She gave to everyone and asked for nothing but a smile in return.
