Following her death Aug. 5 in Cheyenne, services for Alta L. Rhoads, 78, were at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel, Aug. 8, Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating.

She was born in Smithland, Iowa, Aug. 10, 1906 the daughter of Charles and Avis DeLine, later moving with her family to a ranch near Spotted Horse where she was reared and received her education.
