

7-31 EMMA MARIE ROBINSON 1985

Services for Emma Marie Robinson, 84, who died in Wheatland July 31, were held at 10 a.m. Friday, Aug. 2, in St. Patrick Catholic Church with Monsignor Kimmett officiating. A Rosary service was held at 7:30 p.m. Monday.

Robinson was born in St. Libory, Nebr., on March 20, 1901, the daughter of William and Emma Kuiper. When she was 8 the family moved to Wyoming where they filed a homestead in the Flat Top area east of Glendo. She was raised on the homestead, attending county schools and then college for one year.

She taught country schools in the Flat Top area and in Niobrara Co. She and Vern Robinson were married Jan. 18, 1920. They farmed and ranched near her home until 1946 when they moved to a farm near Wheatland.

When her husband died in 1951, Emma continued to operate the farm until ill health created the need for extended nursing care.

She was active in the Altar and Rosary Society at St. Patrick Church, serving as president for several years. She also cooked Saturday night dinners at the Moose Lodge for many years.

Survivors include her daughter, Mrs. Germaine Birkle of Wheatland, two brothers: William J. Kuiper of Norwalk, Calif., Clarence Kuiper of Denver, a sister, Mrs. John Mylet of New Mexico, eight grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband, son Lavern, and infant son, a sister and three brothers.

Memorial contributions in her name may be made to the Catholic Church Building Fund.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
