

ROBINSON, VERNARD FRANK

August 18, 1895-June 11, 1951

Services for Vernard Frank Robinson, resident of Wheatland for the past four years, were held this morning (Thursday) at 9:00 in Schrader chapel.

He was born August 18, 1895 in Palmer, Nebr. And died at his home four miles northeast of Wheatland June 11. He had been ill for some time. Prior to living in Wheatland he had resided in Glendo.
