May 3, 1914-March 8, 1967

James A. Ross, 52, long time resident of Wheatland, succumbed in the Veterans Hospital in Sheridan on March 8, 1967 after an extended illness. He was born in Alliance, Nebr. May 3, 1914 and came to Wheatland as a small boy. The family moved to Wellington, Colo. for several years, and then back to Wheatland. He was a veteran of World War II. Mr. Ross operated a service station and bulk plant for many years preceding his illness.
