

RUTTER, JAMES HENRY
October 16, 1896-May 29, 1942

Funeral services were held from the Copley Funeral Home Monday afternoon, June 1, for James Henry Rutter, who passed away Friday, May 29, in the Wheatland hospital. Rev. C.B. Doughty officiated at the services, with interment in the Wheatland cemetery.

He was born October 16, 1896 in Montana and went to England with his parents as a child. He served with the English Army during the last World War, returning to the United States after the war. He was employed at the Sunrise mine for the Colorado Fuel and Iron Company for several years. On December 1, 1931, he was married Viola Duguid of Ft. Laramie, after which they moved to Wheatland where they have resided since that time.

He is survived by his wife and one four-year old son, James, Jr. and other relatives and a host of friends.

The last he heard of his mother in England, which was a year ago, she was also still living.
