

RYAN, ANNIE

September 30, 1892-August 4, 1921

Miss Annie Ryan, one of the best beloved nurses of the Wheatland Hospital Training School, died from acute peritonitis last Thursday evening after an illness of only a few days. Miss Ryan was planning her summer vacation when she was suddenly stricken with acute peritonitis due to obstruction of the bowels. In spite of all that medical skill could do, her condition rapidly grew desperate, and in a few hours, was pronounced hopeless.

Her brother, J.J. Ryan of Denver, the only relative that she had in America, arrived a short time before her death, together with some friends from Denver.

Funeral services were held from the Catholic church Saturday morning, Father Adolph of Douglas officiating. Besides the brother in Denver, she leaves a father and two sisters in Dublin, Ireland, to mourn her loss.
