

SALLADAY, NINA JOSLIN
June 3, 1890-September 23, 1917

Died Sept. 23, Mrs. Clyde Salladay, at the home of her sister, Mrs. W. E. Stall. The deceased had been ailing for a long time, but was bedfast only two weeks.

Mrs. Salladay, whose maiden name was Nina Joslin, was born in Franklin county, Nebraska, June 3rd, 1890. On June 3rd, 1910, she was married to Clyde Salladay at Brewster, Nebraska and remained in that state until coming to Wheatland a year ago last winter, when they lived for a year on the Klassert farm, and then moved to a farm they purchased south of Rock Lake.

Two little children, aged two and four, are left behind with the husband.

Other relatives who attended the funeral were her father, E. Joslin of Grand Island, Nebr.; a brother, A. Joslin; and a sister, Mrs. Finley, both of Anselmo, Nebr.
