

SALLADAY, NINA JOSLIN  
June 3, 1890-September 28, 1917

Mrs. Nina Salladay, wife of Clyde Salladay, passed away on last Friday, Sept. 28<sup>th</sup>, at the home of her sister, Mrs. W.E. Stall. The deceased had been ailing for some time, but had only been bedfast for the past two weeks.

Funeral services were conducted from Pepper's Mortuary on Saturday by Rev. McClelland, interment being in the Wheatland cemetery.

Nina Joslin was born in Franklin county, Nebraska, June 3, 1890, and was united in marriage to Clyde Salladay at Brewster, Nebraska, on June 3, 1910.
