

SANDBERG, OSCAR EDWIN  
June , 1884-December 30, 1910

Oscar Edwin Sandberg was born in Blackhawk, Colo., June 1884, and was killed December 30, 1910, by the premature explosion of a blasting charge, at the ditch camp on Bluegrass River, about twenty-two miles southwest of Wheatland, age, about 27 years.

His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Chas. Sandberg, reside at Fremont, Nebr. They are well along in years, the father being 69 and the mother 67 years of age.

Two brothers of the deceased, Morris and Henry Sandberg, also reside in the Black Hills, near Rapid City.

Oscar Sandberg, before moving to Nebraska, lived at Hermosa, South Dakota. For some time, his home could not be located, but finally word reached the family, and his brother, Emil Sandberg, came to lay the body away in that long last sleep that knows no awaking, until God shall call the dead to life again. Sad indeed, is the death of this boy, far away from home and kindred. May God comfort the bereaved ones at home, who will never look upon the face of their boy again.

Funeral services were conducted by Rev. J.K. Hicks and the body laid to rest in the Wheatland cemetery on January 9<sup>th</sup>, 1911.
