

SARBAUGH, AMOS  
1856-September 12, 1911

Amos Sarbaugh was born in Ohio in 1856, and died at his home near Wheatland, September 12, 1911, being at the time of his death, 55 years, 3 months and 25 days of age.

Amos Sarbaugh was one of the pioneer residents of Wyoming, coming west 25 years ago. For the past number of years, he was engaged in the ranching and stock raising business, and was one of our most enterprising and highly respected citizens. The deceased had been in poor health the past year or more from an attack of Bright's disease, which together with a complication of diseases, caused his death.

Amos Sarbaugh was married to Ida Sandel in 1880, who with a daughter, Miss Edythe Sarbaugh, survive him.

Funeral services were held on Friday at the M.E. church, being conducted by Rev. J.K. Hicks, and interment was made in Wheatland cemetery.

A host of friends in this section and elsewhere, will be pained to learn of the demise of another of our old-timers, but the memory of the life of Amos Sarbaugh, his cheerful disposition and cheerful character, will be foremost in recollections of the past.
