SARBAUGH, IDA SANDEL October 24, 1863-1924

Mrs. Ida Sarbaugh died early Tuesday morning at her home in Wheatland, after a long illness, known to be fatal for many weeks.

Mrs. Sarbaugh was a resident of long standing in this vicinity, having come here thirty-five years ago with her husband, Amos Sarbaugh from Ohio where she was born October 24, 1863. Mr. and Mrs. Sarbaugh lived for eight years on the Two Bar ranch after their arrival here, after which they moved to the farm east of Wheatland, now owned by T.A. Shaw. Mr. Sarbaugh preceded his wife fourteen years ago. In 1918, Mrs. Sarbaugh sold the farm and built the beautiful residence in town where she spent her last years. Her skill as a gardener made her town residence one of the beauty spots of Wheatland.

The funeral has been arranged for today at 2 P.M. from the Congregational church Rev. R.F. Paxton officiating. The body lay in state for the visit of friends at the home from 10 A.M. until 1 P.M. today.

The deceased was widely known and respected here, and the sympathy of the community is extended to her only child, Mrs. H.C. Havens.
