

## Laura Christina Anna Schad

Funeral services for Laura Christina Anna Schad, age 85, will be held at the Platte Funeral Chapel Wednesday, Nov. 7 (today) at 11 a.m., with Pastor Mark Patzke officiating.

Mrs. Schad died Nov. 2 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital. Interment will be in Wheatland Cemetery.
