Funeral services for Herman E. Schnacker, age 87, were held on Tuesday, August 4, 1970, at the Schrader Chapel in Wheatland. Rev. Carl Richmond officiated at the 10:00 a.m. last rites with interment in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Schnacker died of a brief illness in the Platte Co. Memorial Hospital on August 1. He was born in Kearney, Nebr. on Sept. 22, 1882. He came to Wyoming in 1919 and homesteaded in the Indian Hills until 1924. Later he moved to Meadow, then to the Chugwater area and finally to Wheatland in 1946. He was a retired farmer, and was a member of the Chugwater AF&AM No. 23.

Survivors include his wife, Viola Schnacker of Wheatland; one son, Seth Daniels of Cheyenne; two daughters, Mrs. George Hague of Hayward, California and Mrs. Lucille Carl of Richmond, Calif.; six grandchildren, 18 great grandchildren, and one great great grandchild. One brother and one sister also survive him.
