

SCHOLLE, CLARA ETTA MELTON  
September 20, 1864-February 21, 1952

Nine years of being bedridden from a paralytic stroke ended last Thursday in the death of a loyal wife and loving mother, Mrs. Clara Scholle, who will be greatly missed and remembered with tender affection by all who knew her.

Clara Etta Melton was born in Elizabeth, Indiana on Sept. 20, 1864 and parted this life February 21, 1952, at the age of 88. She was united in marriage to Fred W. Scholle April 11, 1883, and to this union, six children were born, Mrs. Pearl Hurt, Clinton, Mo.; Edward Scholle, Little Rock, Ark.; Edith M. Stanford, Los Angeles; Ross L. Scholle, Claremont, Calif.; Mrs. Zeeta Woodrow, Pomona, Calif.; and Elta M. Searl of Wheatland. In addition to 13 grandchildren and 16 great grandchildren, one brother, Alva Melton of Nevada, Mo., all survive her. Her husband preceded her in death Nov. 18, 1922.

From girlhood, she was a devout member of the Methodist church and attended regularly until her health made it impossible.

Services were held Sunday at 2 p.m. at Schrader Chapel with Rev. Howard Rice officiating. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
