

SCHREYER, CHARLES FREDRICK

December 18, 1900-April 18, 1958

Charles Frederick Schreyer, 57, died suddenly following a hear attack at his ranch 20 miles southwest of Wheatland last Friday. Funeral services were held Wednesday at the Schrader chapel with Rev. Daniel T. Winger in charge. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

The deceased was born to Peter and Wilhelmina Schreyer December 18, 1900 in Brooklyn, N.Y. and had lived here since 1920.
