

SCHROETLIN, WILLIAM

March 2, 1909-July 6, 1988

Services for William Schroetlin, 79, who died in Wheatland July 6, 1988, were held at 10:30 a.m. Monday, July 11, at the Platte Funeral Chapel with Pastor Jim Vuocolo officiating.

Born March 2, 1909 in Fort Collins, Colo., he was the son of Henry and Katharine (Roth) Schroetlin. At an early age he moved with his family to South Dakota. He worked on various ranches in Wyoming.

In 1942 he joined the army and served until 1945.

He and Dolly Callen were married in Scottsbluff, Neb., in November of 1945. He worked for the Government Public Housing in Cheyenne. Later he worked for a time as a tractor driver and then went into the lawn care work in the Wheatland area.

He was a member of the National DAV Commanders Club.

In 1974, he retired. He spent his retirement years in Wheatland.

Survivors include his wife Dolly of Wheatland; brothers, Ed and Ben of Lincoln, Neb., Ted of Sutton, Neb., and Herman of Butte, Neb.; sisters, Erma Franklin and Martha Haas of Lincoln, Lillian Mathieson of Kansas and Esther Brown of Wheatland.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
