

SCHURR, MARK
July 29, 1866-March 9, 1950

Funeral services for an 83-year old man, Mark Schurr, were held Sunday at the Schrader Funeral home with Mr. C. E. Henry in charge of the services.

He died at the home of his son, Carl Schurr, two and a half miles south of Wheatland on March 9 following an extended illness. He had moved to his son's home five weeks ago.

Mr. Schurr was a farmer and had lived on a farm, 18 miles from Glendo since 1918. He was born in Illinois, on July 29, 1866.

His survivors include his wife, Nellie; four children, Chester Schurr of Yuma, Ariz., Miss Mable Schurr, Mrs. Pearl Skoglund and Carl Schurr, all of Wheatland; two sisters, two brothers, four grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

Pallbearers at the funeral Sunday were James Payne, Mike Hammer, William Herman, Fred Smith, Tom Roberts and Walter Vaudrey. Burial took place in the Wheatland cemetery.
