August Henry Schutt, 38, died Monday, April 13, 1981 as a result of injuries sustained in a powerline mishap northeast of Slater.

Gus was born Oct. 4, 1942 in Burwell, Neb. He was raised in the Burwell area and graduated from the Burwell High School in 1960. In the fall of 1960, he entered the U.S. Army, spending most of his military duty in Germany. After he was discharged from the Army, he worked for a ranch for a short time in Burwell and then he accepted a position with Custer Power District in Broken Bow, Neb.

In 1974 he and his family moved to Wheatland where Gus has been employed by the Wheatland REA until the time of his death. Gus was an active outdoors-person who enjoyed hunting, fishing and rock collecting.

He is survived by his father, August Schutt of Ten Sleep; his mother, Norma Taylor of Grand Island, Neb.; his wife, Evelyn; a son, Randy Keerikoolparn; and a daughter, Tina Marie Schutt, all of Wheatland. Surviving also is a brother, James Schutt of Grand Island and a sister, Yvonne Rienke of Milwaukee, Wisc. And five half-brothers and sisters.

Funeral services were held Thursday, April 16 at 10:30 a.m. at the Schrader-Prell Chapel in Wheatland with the Rev. Charles Jaques officiating. Funeral services were also held Friday, April 17 at 1:30 p.m. at the Adams-Swanson Funeral Home in North Platte, Neb. with burial in the McCain Cemetery in Stapleton, Neb.
