Ed Scott, 67, of 1009 14th Street in Wheatland, died Saturday, March 8.

Funeral services were held at 10 a.m. Tuesday at the United Methodist Church with the Rev. Virgil Lamm, officiating.

Scott was born Sept. 6, 1912. The son of Thomas and Thurse Mae Scott, Scott moved from Missouri in 1915 and settled in Kimball, Neb. In October of 1917, the Scott family moved to the Wheatland area.

Scott married Alice McCann on Aug. 13, 1936.

Scott was a mechanic until he served in the Air Force from 1941 to 1946 as a flight instructor. He returned to Wheatland and worked as a mechanic and spray pilot. He also worked for the Wheatland Police Department.

In recent years, he worked at Anderson Ford. He retired in 1978.

He was preceded in death by parents and two brothers, Hubert and Bob Scott.

He is survived by his wife, Alice of Wheatland; four daughters, Karen Kwedor of Casper, Cheri Warner of Burns, Bonnie Billings and Marilyn Yorges, both of Wheatland; three sisters, Margaret Hamm of Sheridan; Ailene Berltel of Cheyenne, Theresa Hawkins of Fontana, Ca.; one brother, Albert (Red) Scott of Wheatridge, Co., 18 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
