

O. Alice Scott

June 20, 1911 – February 27, 2006



Funeral services for O. Alice Scott, 94, were conducted at 11 a.m. Thursday, March 2 at the First Christian Church in Wheatland, with Pastor Andy Gudahl officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

She died Monday, Feb. 27, 2006, at the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland.

Alice was born June 20, 1911, in Cheyenne, the daughter of Anna (Jensen) and George McCann, the oldest of six children. As a young girl, she and her family made their home in Wheatland, where her father was a building contractor. After graduating from Wheatland High School in 1930, she went to work for the telephone company as an operator. Alice met Elda "Ed" Raymond Scott in Wheatland. They eloped to Kimball, Neb., and were married Oct. 13, 1937. They made their home in Wheatland until World War II when they moved to El Reno, Ok., where her husband was stationed during the war. They returned to Wheatland after the war to raise their four daughters. Alice returned to work for Mountain Bell Phone Company; retiring in 1975 after 38 years of service. She was a charter member of the Women of the Moose, a member of the Mountain Bell Pioneers, several card clubs, and volunteered

to deliver meals for Services for Seniors. She enjoyed playing cards, crocheting, reading western books, crafts, and doing puzzle books.

Survivors include her four daughters, Karen Kwedor and husband, Chick of Casper, Bonnie Billings and husband, Keith and Marilyn Larson all of Wheatland, Cheri Warner and husband, Glen of Guernsey; a sister, Hazel Cloyd of Cheyenne; 18 grandchildren; 48 great-grandchildren; and 10 great-great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband of 42 years on March 8, 1980; her parents; two sisters, Anna Shoemaker and Marion Bartholow; two brothers, Melvin McCann and John McCann; a son-in-law, Dale Larson; and one great grandson, Taylor Warner.
