

**PERRY EDWARD SCRANTON**

Services for Perry Scranton, 77, who died in Wheatland, July 2, were held in the First Christian Church in Wheatland at 2 p.m. today with Dan Barcus officiating.

Perry Edward Scranton was born May 15, 1906, the son of Ed and Fannie Scranton, in Miller, Neb. The family traveled by covered wagon to homestead west of Wheatland in the spring of 1909. He ranched all his life, the past few years making his home in Wheatland during the winter and on the ranch during the summer. He married his wife, Kathleen, Nov. 10, 1945.

Besides his wife he is survived by three daughters: Irene Cowell of Silver Spring, Md., Maxine Reynolds of Umatilla, Ore. and Wilda Curtis of Seminole, Tex., by two brothers: Orville Scranton of Wheatland and Dennis Scranton of Pleasant Hill, Calif., a sister, Velma Kennedy of Las Vegas, Nev., four step-children: Alvin Mahrt of Wolbach, Neb., JoAnne Dietz of Laramie, Delmar Mahrt of Birmingham, Mich., and Jerome Mahrt of Edmonton, Alberta, Canada and by several grandchildren and great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a brother Robert, and two sisters: Marion Latta and Elva Rawlings.
