

SEARL, ETHEL LEAH HAVELY
1894-July 23, 1939

Mrs. Ethel Leah Searl, 45, wife of Clarence M. Searl of Laramie, passed away there of a brief illness early Sunday morning.

Mrs. Searl was seized with a serious illness Saturday night and taken to the hospital for treatment where she died about 2 a.m.

A graduate of the University of Wyoming, Mrs. Searl had taught school in the Laramie section for several years. She was a member of a number of scholastic and educational honorary societies.

Besides her husband, survivors of Mrs. Searl include two sisters; Mrs. J.E. Senevey of Lingle and Miss Lulu Havely of Slater; seven brothers, Seigal and Herbert Havely of Slater, Otis Havely of Lingle, Dana, Ora and Mark Havely, all of Wheatland, and Worley Havely of Worland.

Funeral services were held at the Shannon funeral chapel in Laramie Monday and were again held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Copley Funeral Home in Wheatland. Miss Olive Searl and Mrs. San Dearing sang "In the Garden" accompanied at the piano by Mrs. Mark Havely. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Searl who had resided in Laramie about fifteen years, formerly lived in the Wheatland area.
