

SEARL, SOPHIA I. DAVIDSON

March 28, 1870-June 10, 1957

Last rites were held Thursday, June 13, 1957, for Sophia I. Searl, at 2:00 p.m. from the Schrader Chapel. Mrs. Searl passed away June 10 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital following an extended illness.

She was born March 28, 1870 in Benton county, Iowa and had been a resident of this community since 1909. Prior to making her home here, she had lived in Glendo and Laramie. She was a member of the Methodist church and the W.T.C.U.
