

SEARLES, EDNA LEWIS  
August 7, 1890-January 12, 1955

Mrs. Edna Searles of Wheatland died suddenly last Wednesday, January 12, at Glasgow, Mont. where she had been visiting at the home of her daughter. A resident of this community since 1915, Mrs. Searles had made her home with her children during the past few years.

She is survived by five children, nine grandchildren, and three great grandchildren. A son, Emmett Searles, lives in Santa Cruz, Calif., and her four daughters are Mrs. Raymond Wilson of Slater, Mrs. A.H. Treat and Mrs. W.L. Spangler of Wheatland, and Mrs. Viro Jackson of Glasgow, Mont. A sister, Mrs. Oscar Throckmorton of Wheatland, also survives.

Mrs. Searles was born in Missouri August 7, 1890, and was sixty-four years of age at death. She was a member of the Twin Lakes Baptist church in Santa Cruz.

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at the Schrader chapel, with the Rev. Vernon Kruse the officiating clergyman. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery at the side of her husband, Irvin Searles, who preceded her in death several years ago.
