

SEARS, CARROLL FRANK
May 30, 1879-November 16, 1936

Carroll Frank Sears, well known Antelope Gap rancher, passed away at his home Monday morning. The deceased had been in poor health for some time, but his friends were shocked to learn of his sudden demise.

Frank, as he was better known, was born in Monticello, Wisc., and was 57-years, 5-months and 16-days of age at the time of his death. Very little is known about his past history, but it is understood that he lived about 5 miles east of the Gap for a number of years.

He is survived by two brothers, Lester and Edward, both of Hamburg, Iowa. They were both here for the funeral.

Funeral services are being held this afternoon from the Lyla Watson Funeral Home. Rev. C.L. Morton of Guernsey is in charge for the final rites. Interment will take place in the Wheatland cemetery.
