

SELBY, CLARA BELLE BOVEE
September 27, 1892-July 14, 1966

Last rites for Clara Belle Selby, pioneer resident, were held at the Schrader chapel on July 18 at 10:30 a.m. with Rev. Henry Hartberg officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Born in Cheyenne on Sept. 27, 1892, she moved with her family to Wheatland at the age of three. She was married to Albert William Selby in 1911. Death occurred in the Platte County Memorial Hospital on July 14, 1966 following a lengthy illness.

Relatives left to mourn her passing are her husband Albert of Wheatland; an adopted daughter, Mrs. William Frank of Yakima, Wash.; sister, Mrs. Horace Wilson of Wheatland and brothers; Clyde, Donald and Albert Bovee, all of Twisp, Wash. Her parents, Jasper and Rose Bovee, preceded her in death.
