

Glenn Harry Sergel

Graveside services for Glenn Harry Sergel, 83, who died in Hammond, N.Y., Feb. 2, 1988, were held Saturday, Feb. 6, 1988 at 11 a.m. in the Wheatland Cemetery with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating.

Born in Holland, N.Y., Sept. 2, 1904, Glenn Sergel was the son of George and Flora (Brunner) Sergel. He was reared on the family farm and received his education in New York. He remained on the family dairy farm which he operated until his retirement in 1980. His son, Gary remains on the farm today. He was married in New York in 1928. His retirement years have been spent on his daughter and son-in-law's farm in Wheatland.

His American heritage goes back to his family coming to settle this country on the Mayflower.
