

Sylvia L. Sergel

Graveside funeral services for Sylvia L. Sergel, 82, were held Friday, Sept. 6 1991 at 10:30 a.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery with the Rev. Susan D. Phifer officiating.

Sylvia Sergel died Tuesday, Sept. 3 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland following a long illness.

She was born Feb. 19, 1909 at Pierre, S.D., the daughter of Joseph and Minnie (Winkleman) Weisner. She moved to Buffalo, N.Y. as an infant, where she was reared and educated.

On Jan. 17, 1928, she married Glenn Sergel at Porterville, N.Y., and moved to Java Village, N.Y., where she and her husband ran a dairy farm until their retirement in 1980.
