

Memorial services for one time Wheatland resident Archie Settell, 61, were held on Tuesday at Our Saviour's Lutheran Church, Casper with Pastor Allen Cudahy officiating.

Mr. Settell died July 10, 1986 at his home in Mills following a short illness. Born July 14, 1924 in Shenandoah, Iowa, he moved with his parents to Slater, Wyo. He was reared and educated in Wheatland.

Mr. Settell was employed by a Wheatland bakery. He entered the U.S. Army during World War II and served with the 82nd Airborne Division in Germany.

On May 15, 1947 he married Maria Plagwitz in Casper. In 1957, he was employed by the Amoco Refinery and had a part-time business installing sprinkler systems. He retired from Amoco in 1980. An avid golfer, he also enjoyed hunting, fishing and sports.

He was a member of Our Saviour's Lutheran Church and BPOE Lodge No. 1353 of Casper.

Besides his widow, he is survived by one son Ron Settell, Lovell; a daughter, Mrs. Dorothy Hunter, Casper; his mother, Leona Settell, Wheatland; four brothers, Gus Settell, Wheatland, Leland Settell, Belfry, Mont., Rand Settell, Prior Lake, Minn., and Darrell Settell, Portland, Me.; four sisters, Marie Skaggs and Iona Hoge, both of Lakewood, Calif., Aileen Gudahl, Gering, Neb., and Vonda Donahoo, Sebree, Ky.; five grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
