Floy C. Schafer, 85, died Tuesday, Dec. 30, 1980 at her home.

Floy was born in Guthrie Center, Iowa, Oct. 4, 1895. She was married to William E. Schafer in Torrington Mar. 1, 1924.

She received her education in Iowa, graduating from Normal College to become a school teacher. Her first teaching job was in South Dakota. From here she moved to Meriden, Wyo. to teach school.

After she and William were married, they moved to North Dakota for a year.

They then moved to Arcolo, Wyo. in 1925. Then in 1929, they moved to the Slater area to work on a farm. During the winter of 1931, they moved into Wheatland and she has resided here until the time of her death.

She is survived by three sons, Andrew of Miles City, Mont.; Max of Wheatland, and Ralph of Bessemer, Ala.; seven grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Aug. 21, 1960; four brothers; and three sisters.

Funeral services were held Friday, Jan. 2, 1981 at 2 p.m. at the First Christian Church. Daniel Barcus officiated. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
