

SCHAFFER, FREDERICK N.
September 25, 1911-August 5, 1959

Frederick N. Schaffer was killed instantly in an accident, Wednesday on the Nimmo ranch, 25 miles north of Cheyenne. He was operating a haystacker at the time of the accident.

Officers who investigated the accident said Schaffer apparently drove the back wheels of the stacker into an irrigation ditch. As he was getting out of the machine he apparently tripped the hydraulic lever operating the lift and the lift bar fell striking Schaffer, breaking his neck. He was brought to Wheatland by Coroner Schrader.

Mr. Schaffer was born in Albany County September 25, 1911.

Besides his wife Mary, he is survived by his mother, Mrs. Mary Schaffer of Wheatland, a son, Joseph, four daughters, Bonnie, Sharon and Donna and Mrs. Loretta Matheson all of Wheatland; four brothers, John of Laramie, William of Bosler, Charles of Wheatland and Frank, Steamboat Springs, Colo.; four sisters, Mrs. Anna Patten and Mrs. Francis Miller of Wheatland, Mrs. Rose Stacy and Mrs. Flora Stacy of Laramie. One uncle Pete Patten also survives.

Services will be held Saturday at 2 p.m., from the Trinity Lutheran Church with Rev. John Kuntz officiating and interment will be in the Wheatland cemetery.
