

SHELDON, LEO B.

July 9, 1881-July 13, 1964

Leo B. Sheldon, born in Decatur, Mich., on July 9, 1881, to Arthur and Catherine Bertine Sheldon, succumbed in the Platte County Memorial hospital on July 13, 1964, after a short illness. Sheldon, who had worked for the Wheatland Irrigation District for several years, was retired.

The deceased moved with his parents to Redlands, Calif., when he was small, later moving to Laramie Peak and Sand Creek country. In 1898, he was employed by the Swan Land and Cattle Co., and on January 21, 1908 married Lizzie Strait. They moved to the Wheatland Reservoir on the Laramie Plains, where they lived for many years. Mr. Sheldon was a member on the Chugwater Masonic Lodge.

Services will be held Friday at 2:00 o'clock in the Schrader chapel, with Masonic graveside services at the Wheatland cemetery. Serving as pallbearers will be Wayne King, George Dodge, James Angle, Charles Preuit and Don Jewett.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. William E. Dawson of Artesia, N.M.; a half-brother, Don Mudd, Laramie; and four grandchildren. His wife, Lizzie, and son Arthur preceded him in death.
